Professor at the Department of Architecture of the University of Coimbra (DARQ/FCTUC) since 1993. Researcher at Centro de Estudos Sociais, Coimbra University - Cities, Cultures and Architecture Department. Guest Lecturer at the Faculty of Architecture of Oporto since 2006, at

Architectural and Urban Culture. His architectural practice merges his condition as teacher, critic, curator and cultural programmer.

Paulo Providência (Coimbra, Portugal 1962)

His architectural practice is concerned with programmatic responses, such as the S. Nicolau baths and wash house (Porto 1992), renovation of S. Salvador de Figueiredo Church (Braga 1996-98), workshops for the Teatro Nacional João (Porto 2001-04) and a Medical Healthcare Centre (Vila do Conde 2001-05).

He is preparing the publication of his PhD thesis about the loss of experience and the promises of architecture in modernity (A estação termal no séc. XIX: representação e experiência).

Kieran Long is journalist, writer and architecture critic. He is pursuing a PhD at London Metropolitan University
